We were also able to address health and safety issues, communication tips from Susan who had attended a communication toolkit workshop and we reviewed our standing committees, acute action plans and long term care recruitment initiatives.

Currently the union leave language has been addressed through Bill 29 and meetings with human resources and health authorities are being planned. I attended my first PHSA board meeting which was very informative and I plan to go to the next one August 21st. Neil and I recently compiled our Repair the Care surveys and will be attending a train the trainer workshop on Sept 5th. The NBA PHSA committee meets July the 8th which will review the front-line leader positions, violence prevention update, workload issues, and how responsive scheduling is going.
